Now for some important info

1. Susan Bates has agreed to collect the fees for the league. The cost is \$30. If paying by cash, place in envelope with your name on outside. If check, make it out to Susan Bates. Your name should appear on the check.

2. The league will keep record of raw scores and game scores. This will keep the playing field level. If you have a GHIN and wish to follow the new GHIN rules of "Net Double Bogey", you will need to keep your score separately. FYI: That means for league play, we will record your raw score with no adjustments. For GHIN scoring, players record double bogey plus what their handicap allows per hole on their own scorecard. Those of you with GHIN numbers know what that would be based on the handicaps of each hole.

3. The infamous #4/13. The water on this hole has always been a menace to our play. Please note, if you land in water before the lake or on the other side of the lake and it is not IN the lake, you can remove/replace that ball with no penalty. Just place the ball no closer to the hole. Hope this helps.
